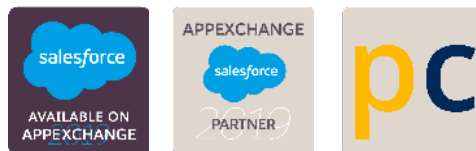

## What's New

- Now you can set different consent expiry dates on the basis of Data use purpose records.
- Now you can delete records up to 3 levels in RTBF via DSAR /APEX and REST.
- You can also delete criteria based Parent level records by scheduling it via Data Retention.

## Product Enhancements

- Delete records under RTBF can be enabled at Organization level under custom settings.
- Delete checkbox fields are now added on each for Parent, Child & Grandchild objects of De-identification UI layout.
- Button name under Data Subject records has been changed from 'De-Identify Records' to 'Process Records'
- New picklist value in field 'DSAR Status' on Case object has been added 'Processed'
- Email field is now optional in Data Retention
- 'PCL Audience' & 'PCL Category' fields on Individual object has been renamed to 'Audience' & 'Category'

## Fixes

- 'Consent Renewal(months)' field on the Configuration setting page has been removed now.
- Now Portability mapping does not auto-populate all fields with respect to that object.

## Known Issues

- Site base URL from the configuration setting does not override the URL in Custom Metadata settings for now.
